➤ **Dane Street Youth**

Purpose: To develop a gospel-minded community of teenagers where students can fellowship and grow in their relationship with Jesus.

Dane Street Youth will meet regularly on Sunday nights (middle school students from 5 – 6:30 PM; high school students from 6:30 – 8 PM) to play games, hear/discuss a gospel-centered Bible lesson, and pray/worship together.

➤ **High School Christian Education**

Purpose: To train high school students how to read the Bible with the result that they know, love, and obey God better.

The High School Christian Education class will meet regularly during the Christian Education hour (9-10 AM on Sundays) in the Dane Street Youth room upstairs. First, the class will learn how to figure out what the Bible meant for its original readers and what it means for Christians today. This will involve discussion about passages in *How to Read the Bible for All Its Worth* and practice in making basic observations of biblical texts. Later, the class will study individual books of the Bible (alternating between the Old Testament and New Testament) using the methods which the students have learned.

➤ **Events**

Purposes are varied: To encourage Christian fellowship; to provide opportunities for youth to grow in their relationship with God; and/or to provide opportunities for Christian youth to share their faith with non-Christian friends.
